Information and Thoughts on Two of Our Special Events

In the past few years, our chapter has been given the opportunity to participate and display motors and boats at some pretty special venues. By way of invitation, we have displayed at the Grosse Point Yacht Club, Suburban Collection Showplace “Outdoorama” and most recently at the Greenfield Village “Motor Muster.” In one way or another these were special events aside from the usual GLC meets and special in the sense that either space was limited or the display theme was prescribed by the host organization. The “Yacht Club” event came off of our schedule because of a change in their participant requirements.

This year (2024) we again have been invited to participate in two of these events: “Outdoorama” and “Motor Muster.” As the contact person for these two events, let me share some planning information.

Outdoorama- February 22- 25, with set-up on the 21st. At this show we are guests of an adjoining display. Our allotted space is limited, yet this show is likely the best opportunity that we have for exposure of our hobby to the outdoor/ sporting public. Literally thousands of people will come by our display during the four-day show. Because of the limited display space, we must know in advance what you intend to bring and most importantly WHEN YOU WILL BE IN ATTENDANCE. We have again been invited by the Dearborn Early Engine Club and Greenfield Village to display boats and motors. Each year, we have been asked to do a curated display themed to complement the stylish automobiles on display. For 2024 the automotive theme will be “All Things Chrysler” so we are looking for an assortment of Chrysler outboards and maybe even a Chrysler boat. If you can help, let me know. We will be free to display other nice original and restored motors and boats as well. If you will be available for this event let me know, and as I did last year, you may be hearing from me with requests for display items.

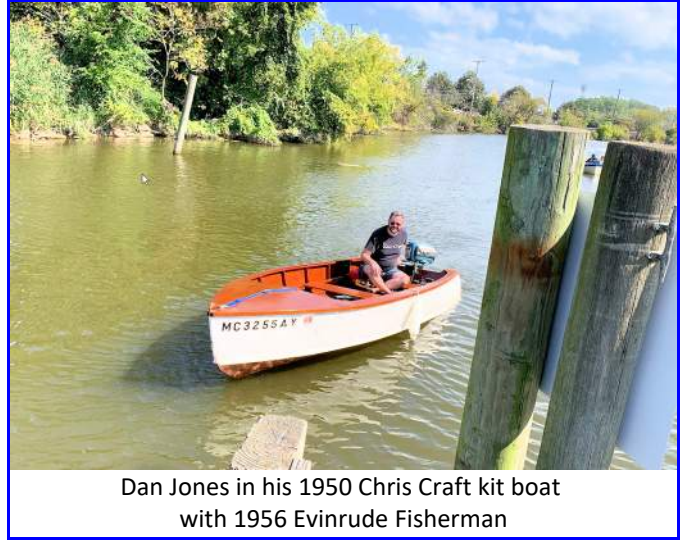

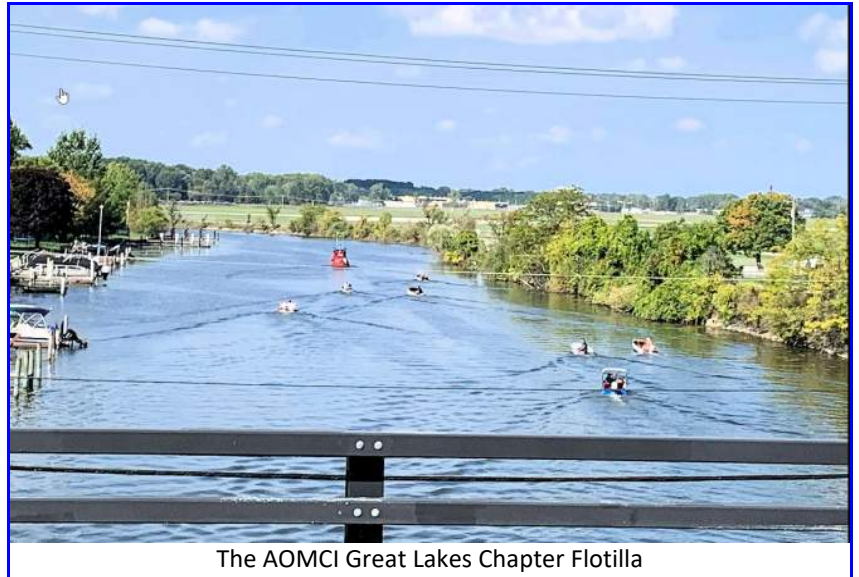

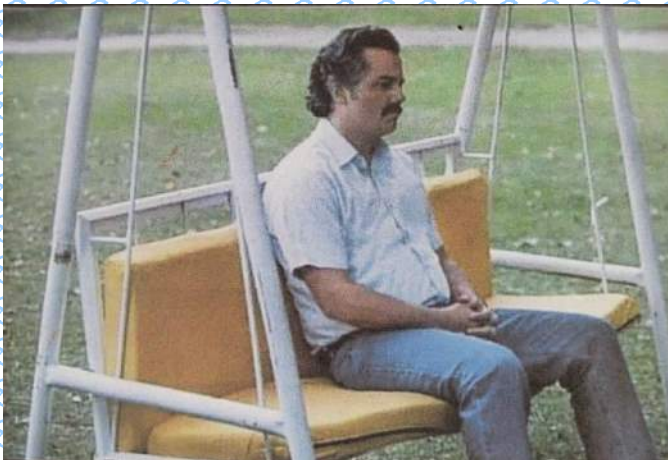

Unusual Water Bodies in Michigan

Lake Dubonnet (also called Big Mud Lake), near Interlochen, has a one-acre floating island, complete with 40 foot trees and brush, that is blown across the surface by the wind.

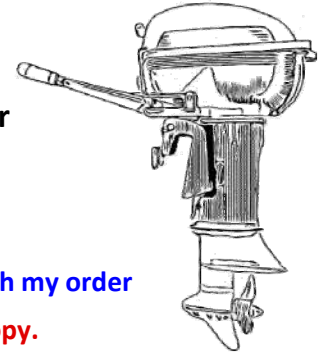
The little **Oqueoc River** (Presque County) dives underground near Oqueoc Falls, disappears as it takes a 500-foot shortcut through limestone slabs, then reappears on the other side of a hill.

Rainy Lake (Millersburg) When water action periodically disturbs sediment and debris from the lake's bottom, it empties through holes into a series of underground limestone chambers as though someone pulled a bathtub plug. Then when mud and silt plug the cracks and holes, the 200-acre lake, which drained completely dry in 1894, 1925, and 1950, fills up again.
